Schedule:	7:45 – 8:15	Locate rooms, get organized and eat.
	8:15	Students report to Field House Student meeting
	8:55	Students performing at the High School, Proceed to Round I rooms

Rounds: After round 1, you should wait in the commons or field house until it is close to the time for your second round to begin. Please remain quiet in the hall while competitions are in session. Do not enter a room if the door is shut (a judge may still be finishing up from the previous round). **In no case should a student enter a room if the judge is not present.** This is an MLFA (Middle Level Forensics Association) rule. You can be disqualified from competition if you break this rule.

Food: Snacks and beverages will be sold in the commons at both Webster and the High School throughout the morning. Pizza and subs will be available at about 9:30. **All food and soda must remain in the commons or cafeteria.** You will be allowed to take water bottles to other parts of the building.

Coats and other belongings: You may store coats and other belongings in the field house at the High School, or you may carry them with you. Lost and found items can be turned in or retrieved at the information booth in the lobby between the field house and the commons/cafeteria.

Questions: If you get lost, have a question, need a map, or need a schedule, stop at the information booth in the lobby between the field house and the commons/ cafeteria. Look for the man in the red jacket.
