Did You Know....How many saints are there? The Catholic Church defines a saint broadly as anyone who lived a holy life and is in heaven with God—so of course, no one knows how many actual saints there are. The church has named about 10,000 saints officially. Saints began to be officially recognized in the 2nd century, first martyrs and then other holy men and women. In the early centuries people became saints through popular acclamation rather than a formal process. Today a person judged to have lived a life of heroic virtue starts the path to sainthood by being named "venerable" by the church. Each of the next two steps, beatification and canonization, requires evidence of one miracle (except in the case of martyrs), which is considered proof that the person is in heaven and can intercede for us. Canonization does not "make" a person a saint; it recognizes what God has already done. *At Home with our Faith*
