You may want to place this link under your FAVORITES on your home computer for future reference. The Username and Password would be the same one used by your child to take the AR tests in school. (These do not change from year to year.) On the home page, there is a tab at the top for "Email Set-up." Entering your email account allows you to receive notification each time your child takes a test. In your child's account, you can click on "View My Bookshelf" to review all of the tests which have been taken during their years at SFCS.
