**Last Day of School** – Our last day of school for this year ends with a 9:00 AM Mass in church on Wed., June 9<sup>th</sup>. After Mass the students will come back into school to receive their report cards and dismissal will be around 10:15 for busses and 10:20 for walkers and riders. We would like to wish everyone a fun and safe summer and we will see you back here on August 31 for our Open House and welcome back picnic.

**Tuition Statements** – We have sent home statements to everyone that had any kind of a balance for tuition so these balances can be brought down to zero by the end of this school year. June 15<sup>th</sup> would be a great cut off date so when we charge everyone the new fees and tuition we can start over with a clean slate. **School Picnic/Free Hot Lunch** – The end of year school picnic will be on Monday, June 7<sup>th</sup> starting with a picnic lunch at 11:30. A hotdog lunch will be served to the entire school so no need to pack a lunch that day. We are looking for volunteers to help set-up, do some prep work and to serve lunch. **Coin War Thank you!** - Thank you to all the wonderful students of SFC! The recent Coin War for Haiti sponsored by 8<sup>th</sup> grade Cadette G.S. Troop 2981 raised an unbelievable \$2, 147.10!!! The class winner of the Ice Cream Party for 1-4 grades was Mrs. Endlich's class, the winner for grades 5-8 was Mrs. Royes class, and the winner of the Kindergarten rooms was Mrs. Kraemer's class. This project is part of the Silver Award, the highest award a Cadette girl scout can earn. The week began by weighing the amount of food wasted in the cafeteria – 30 lbs. of food was thrown out. The next day, the girls gave a 15 minute presentation to each class on what it is like to be poor in the following countries: the U.S., Russia, China, Congo, and Haiti. The Coin War was the following week. The money raised has gone directly to the St. Joseph Missions in Haiti. The last part of the project is to make a box that will be a permanent display at the school for those at the day school and Religious Ed. to put toys such as unopened McDonald toys, new tennis balls, dolls (Polly Pocket size), and Matchbox cars that are to be donated. Lastly, they will be making about 100 gospel bracelets to be sent down to Haiti to be sold for the St. Joseph Mission. Thank you for all your support and effort! It is a blessing!
